

PUBLIC NOTICE SMOKE FREE BYLAW



Council has given first reading to Bylaw #1397/2006 – a bylaw that proposes to prohibit smoking in workplaces and all public places (including those places that do not allow minors):

- drinking establishments
- patios
- public transportation vehicles
- grandstands
- restaurants
- sidewalk cafes
- private clubs
- entrances to buildings

Under the provisions of the Bylaw, individuals who smoke in non-smoking areas or business owners who do not comply with the Bylaw are liable to fines ranging from \$250.00 to \$2,000.00.
