Green Programs

& Initiatives

1 Mandatory Water Conservation

April 1 - October 31, Annually

- **All homes:** Watering ban everyday: 10:00 AM - 7:00 PM
- **Odd numbered homes:** water lawn, garden, or yard on odd numbered days
- **Even numbered homes:** water lawn, garden, or yard on even numbered days
- **Hand watering:** water by hand with a water jug on any day of the week, any time of day
- **New sod or seed:** water on any day of the week, any time of day

2 Rain Barrel Rebate*

50% rebate (max \$50) on the cost of a rain barrel of your choice. Limited to \$100 per account.

3 Toilet Rebate*

\$100 credit: replace one high volume toilet with a toilet that uses 6.0 litres or less.

4 Backyard Composter Rebate*

50% rebate on the cost of a backyard composter, limited to \$50, on the composter of your choice

* Rain Barrel, Toilet, and Composter Rebates

- * An application form and original purchase receipt is required. Funding is limited
- * Rebate credit applied to utility account where rebate is claimed / toilet(s) have been replaced
- * Rebates are applied to your utility account

5 Pitch-in Week, April 29 - May 5

Register a neighbourhood, team or organization to help clean up our community! We supply garbage bags, and bag pick-up

6 Free Tree Branch Drop Off

April 28 - May 3 & September 29 - October 4

Drop off tree branches at the Waste Transfer Site for free. Sylvan Lake residents only. Small loads only, cut branches to 1.5 m. Unload by hand.

7 Yard & Kitchen Waste

May 6 to October 24

- Separate your yard/kitchen waste from your regular household garbage
- Place your yard and kitchen waste together in an approved and labelled container
- Labels available at 5012 48 Ave or 1 Industrial Dr
- Yard/kitchen waste is collected on the same day as your garbage collection day.
- Place yard/kitchen waste one metre away from garbage and recycling carts
- Yard/kitchen waste is also accepted for free at the Waste Transfer Site during regular business hours

Approved containers for Yard & Kitchen Waste:

- A durable container, no larger than 100 litres, with a tight-fitting lid with an approved label or a biodegradable compostable bag (paper only - no larger than 66 cm x 91 cm)
- A yard/kitchen waste container and contents must weigh 23 kg or less to be eligible for collection

8 Large Item Pickup

May 13 and October 1

Registration deadlines: For May 13, register by May 9, 11:30 AM. For Oct 1, register by Sep 26, 11:30 AM

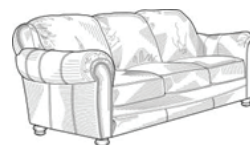

We accept items with freon, such as a fridge or freezer.

Place items to the front road.

Leave items out until collected

(up to 5 days). Three item max.



9 Kick it to the Curb, August 16 - 17

Place your unwanted, reusable household items on the curb on Aug 16, marked with a "FREE" sign.

- Bring uncollected items back into your home by 7:00 PM on August 17
- Safe items only, no children's items
- Post your kick it to the curb items on our Facebook event: sylvanlake.ca/waste

10 Toxic Waste Round-up

September - TBA

Get rid of household chemicals and cleaning supplies. Household/residential volumes only.

12 Recycling

- Recycling is collected every second week, place cart by 8:00 AM on collection day.

13 Drop N Swap Recycling

Leave or swap gently used items free of charge, year-round at the Sylvan Lake Waste Transfer Site, during regular hours (no after-hours access).

We do not accept: car seats, BBQs, mattresses, bedding, box springs, large appliances, unsafe items.

14 Waste Transfer Site

Summer Hours April - October

- Monday - Saturday, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM
- Open late, until 8:00 PM on Wednesdays

Winter Hours November - March

- Wednesday - Saturday, 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM

Location: 5150 30 St (1 km east of the roundabout on Highway 11A and 0.5 km south on RR12)
