Alberta Support Contact Centre

Utility Disconnection | May be able to cover the cost for utility disconnections. The applicant must be able to provide a disconnection notice. All applications are assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Income Support | Monthly benefits for those people who no longer qualify for EI but are unable to find employment. Medical benefits are also available for those who qualify with a note from a doctor confirming the applicant is unable to work.
