


TOWN CONSENT REQUIRED

The Town of Sylvan Lake requires a semi-waterfront land owner who intends to place a seasonal dock or other mooring structure onto the bed and shore of the lake to apply for a Park Space Permit. A semi-waterfront property is a parcel of land that is separated from the lake by an Environmental Reserve parcel that is owned by the Town.

Landowners must obtain Town consent prior to placing any structures including docks within the Environmental Reserve.


Review the Province's <u>Disturbance</u>

FRIENDLY REMINDERS

- If your dock exceeds the Disturbance Standard you must apply to the Province for approval
- Removal of aquatic vegetation must adhere to the Disturbance Standard
- No activity is permitted that damages or modifies the bed and shore of the lake; or obstructs public access along the bed and shore.









Figure 2. Coterminous Line




In being granted a Park Space Permit to access the Town's Environmental Reserve, the undersigned hereby unconditionally

This application will be reviewed and signed by the Town of Sylvan Lake's Parks Department and assigned a permit number before it is considered approved. The applicant should allow a minimum of five (5) business days for the permit to be processed.

Conditions of Use:

- Any person taking out a park space access permit will be responsible for the repair and damage or disturbance caused to the Park or Open Space, including, but not limited to, utility and irrigation systems, plant material, fencing, or any other structure.
- The Town, at its own discretion, may conduct a post installation inspection.
- Seasonal mooring structures (docks, boat lifts, swimming platforms) must be removed from the water by October 31.
- No storage of docks, boat lifts or other mooring structures is permitted within the Town's environmental reserve.
- Yearly renewals are required to access park space for the placement of seasonal docks and mooring structures.
- The issuance of this permit serves to give the applicant permission to access the bed and shore of the lake through the Town's Environmental Reserve. It does not give the applicant the exclusive right to use the Environmental Reserve.
- The issuance of this permit does not grant the applicant the right to place a structure in the
 waterbody. The applicant is required to ensure their docks meet the Province's Disturbance
 Standard or apply for any necessary provincial approvals prior to placing the structure in the water.
- This permit serves as the Town's written consent to access Town lands for the purposes of a Provincial application for a dock authorization that exceeds the Disturbance Standard.
- Prior to removing any vegetation, the applicant is responsible to ensure the amount to be removed and the method in which it may be removed meets the guidelines of the Disturbance Standard.
