What to look for in your STAR

HOME SAFEY & EVACUATION FLOOR PLAN

The plan must contain all exits and be displayed in each bedroom, sleeping space and in the entryway of the STAR. The plan must include:

- identify all rooms (bedrooms, kitchen, livingroom, etc)
- identify the location of a sleeping space is you are applying for one
- identify all the doors and windows
- identify all fire extinguishers and their location
- identify the fire exit from the STAR for each bedroom and sleeping space

relax with confidence

The Town of Sylvan Lake requires all short term accommodation rentals (STARs) to be licensed. Licensing helps ensure the quality and safety of accommodations for visitors and provides guidance for hosts.

What is a STAR?

The business of offering a home, or a portion of, to a guest for a stay of 28 days or less.

OCCUPANCY

- Maximum of 2 adults per bedroom
- children under the age of 18 years does not calculate into the occupancy
- Maximum of 1 additional sleeping space with 2 adults maximum (if applied for)
- Parking is based on the number of bedrooms applied for

As a licensed operator, your host is required to follow the rules set out in the Short-Term Accommodation Rental Licensing Bylaw #1842/2021
